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Most children and teenagers in Britain receive pocket money from their parents. They start getting pocket money when they are 6 or 7 years old. Sometimes they have to do **some jobs** to get their pocket money. For example, they help at home cleaning or cooking.

Children receive different amounts of money and logically teenagers get more money than younger children. Some children use their pocket money to buy toys and games.
