Dinosaurs

Dinosaurs lived millions of years ago during an Era that was known as the "Age of the Dinosaurs" or the "Mesozoic Era". They are recognized as giant reptiles that lived during the Triassic period about 230 million years ago. The last one died out over 65 million years ago leaving us with many questions about the reasons of their extinction. The first dinosaur fossil was discovered in the 19th century. Since then, people have become very interested in the largest animals that ever lived. There were different kinds of dinosaurs. Scientists have named about 300 kinds and are still discovering new kinds every day. The most famous ones are the Tyrannosaurus Rex, Spinosaurus, Diplodocus and Brachiosaurus. Dinosaur fossils have been found in places as far apart as the USA, China, Australia and Antarctica. Although there aren't any dinosaurs alive today, we do have some of their relatives. Scientists think that birds are distant relatives of dinosaurs because their skeletons are similar.
