worry + **es** = worries

dry + **ing** = drying

copy + **ed** = copied

fry + **ing** = frying

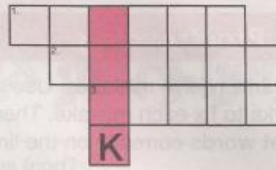

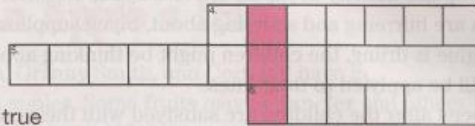

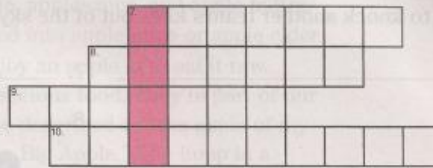
