a 'You have probably seen a musical on TV or at the cinema, but have you seen a musical at the theatre? It's one of the most enjoyable experiences you can have, a musical mixes singing, acting and sometimes dancing to tell a story. There are many different styles of musical, such as jazz, pop, rock. b 'Have you ever sung karaoke? If you have visited Asia, maybe you have sung at a KTV bar. KTV is a restaurant with private rooms where you pay to go and sing karaoke. Each room has a big screen that plays the music and shows the lyrics to the song you choose. You can order food and drinks and spend a few hours singing with friends. KTV bars started in Asia and are really popular there and now you can find KTV in the USA, Canada and Europe. I have sung at KTV many times and they are great fun!'

c 'If you are a fan of jazz music, then visiting the home of jazz, New Orleans, is a musical experience that you can't miss! You don't need to buy expensive tickets to listen to amazing jazz musicians, you can just go for a walk around the French Quarter of New Orleans and there is live jazz music everywhere, from the cafés to bands playing on the streets. There is a jazz festival every spring, but you can hear jazz all year in this musical city. A fantastic experience!'
