fashion show (n phr.) /fæʃn ʃo:/	a performance for the public where models wear new designs of clothes	There is a fashion show next Sunday.
puppet show (n phr.) /pʊpɪt ʃo:/	a performance in which artists use strings to make models of people or animals move	The children like to watch a puppet show.
tug of war (n) /tʌg əv wɔ:/	a kind of sport in which two teams use their strength to pull a rope over a line	Do they like playing a tug of war?
talent show (n) /tælənt ʃo:/	a competition to find the person with the most ability in any field	The talent show starts at 5 p.m. and ends at 9 p.m.

Grammar

Present Simple for the future use

- We usually use the **Present Simple** for something scheduled to happen in the future.

Affirmative The performance takes place at 3.30 tomorrow afternoon.

Negative The food stand doesn't open on Sundays.

Question What time does the fashion show start? - It starts at 8 a.m.
Does the festival start at 9 a.m.? - Yes, it does. / No, it doesn't.
