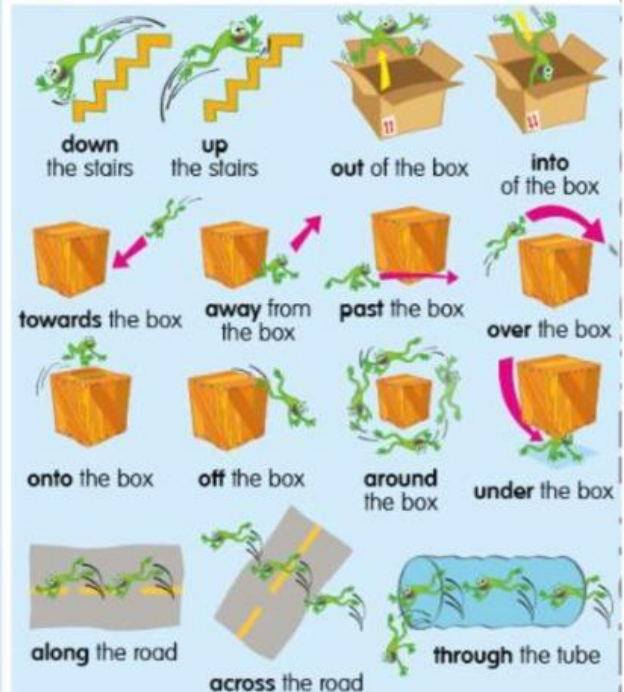
Façons de se déplacer : verbes
