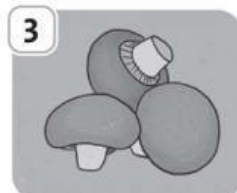

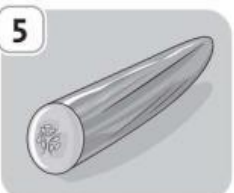

Nouns can be countable or uncountable. Countable nouns are things that you can count. Uncountable nouns are things that you cannot count.

We use **a**, **an**, or **one** before a singular countable noun.  
**an** onion, **a** mushroom, **one** melon

We can use numbers or **some** before plural countable nouns.  
**three** onions, **two** mushrooms, **some** melons.

We use **some** before uncountable nouns.  
Uncountable nouns don't have a plural form. We don't use **a** or **an**.  
**some** iced tea, **some** meat

We can use **that** before any noun.  
*I'd like **that** melon.*

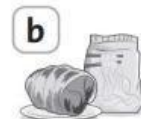
