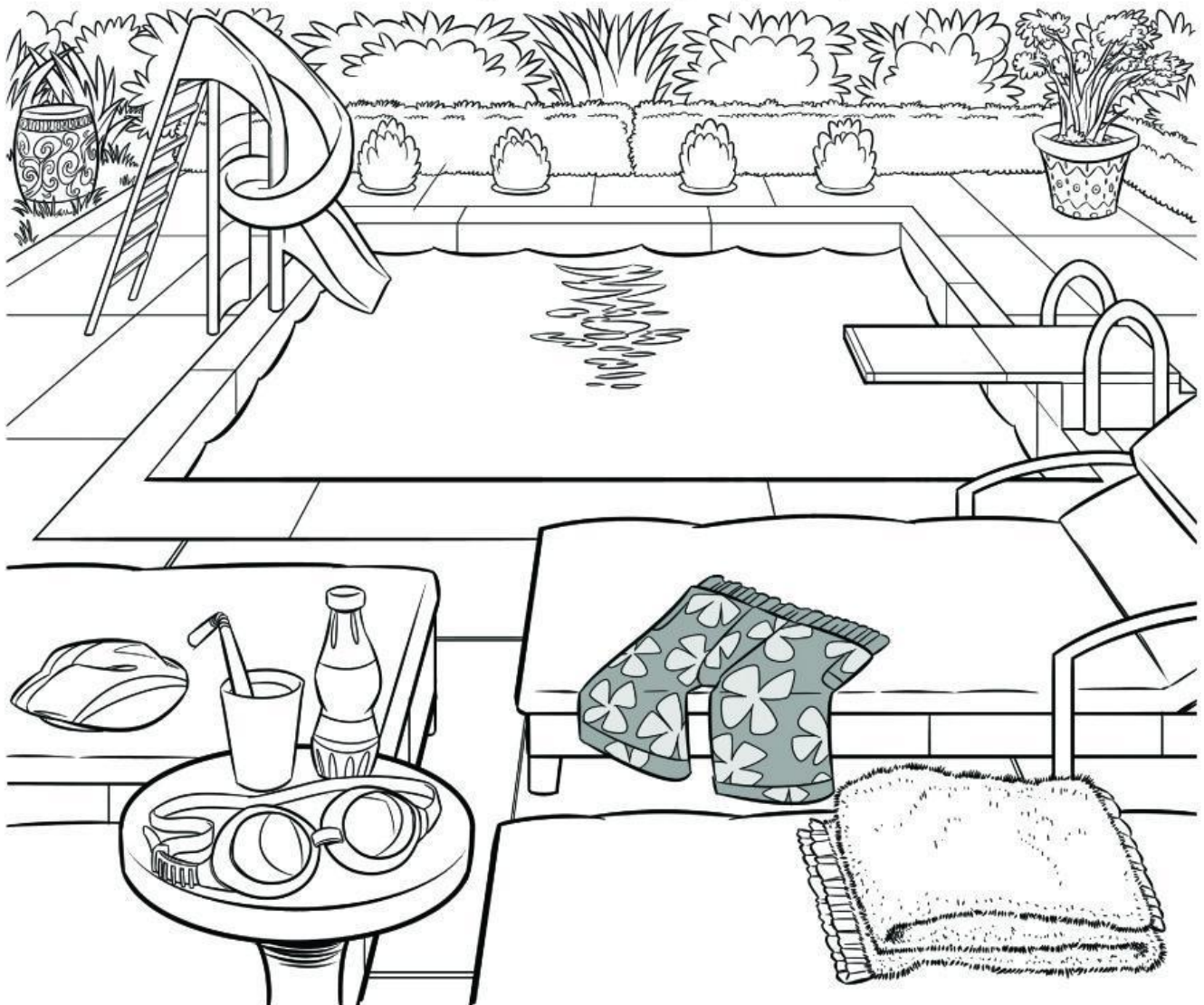

The Tuba

The tuba is the grandfather of the brass instruments. It is the largest brass instrument. It can be about 3 meters in size. Tubas have about 5 meters of tubing. There is usually one tuba in an orchestra. You must play the tuba sitting down with it on your lap because it is very heavy. You blow into a large mouthpiece and use your hand to press down on the valves to change the sound. It takes a lot of air and strong lungs to make sounds with the tuba!
