1. ¿Qué son las cláusulas relativas?

Las **cláusulas relativas** son oraciones subordinadas que describen o aportan información adicional sobre un sustantivo.

En inglés comienzan con un **pronombre relativo**, que puede ser:

who

whom

whose

which

that

where

when

why

2. ¿Cuándo se usan?

Se usan para:

Identificar o especificar un sustantivo.

*The book **that I bought** is interesting.*

Agregar información adicional sobre un sustantivo ya conocido.

*My brother, **who lives in Spain**, is visiting us.*

Conectar ideas evitando repetición.

En vez de: *I met a girl. The girl is an engineer.*

Puedes decir: *I met a girl **who is an engineer**.*

3. Ejemplos de cada pronombre relativo

a) Who (personas, sujeto)

*The teacher **who helped me** was very kind.*

b) Whom (personas, objeto)

*The person **whom you saw** is my cousin.*

c) Whose (posesión)

*The student **whose laptop broke** needs help.*

d) Which (cosas o animales)

*The car **which I rented** was very comfortable.*

e) That (personas o cosas; estilo neutral)

*The movie **that we watched** was excellent.*

f) Where (lugares)

*This is the restaurant **where we met**.*

g) When (tiempo)

*I remember the day **when we first talked**.*

h) Why (razón)

*Do you know the reason **why he left early**?*
