(1) Before the discovery of oil, Qatar had only a small number of schools scattered across a few parts of the country. Education was limited, and only a few children were able to learn basic reading and writing skills. Most lessons took place in simple and traditional settings, such as mosques, small community majlis areas, or private homes where an elder or a learned person would teach the children. Resources were very limited, and students usually relied on wooden boards or simple notebooks. Today, the situation is completely different. Education is provided free of charge for all citizens, and every child has the opportunity to study in modern, well-equipped schools built throughout the country. This progress has helped Qatar **develop** a strong educational system for future generations.

(2) The government has fully realised how important education is for the young people of Qatar, especially in building a strong and successful society. Because of this, it has built many new schools for children of all ages, from kindergarten to secondary school. These schools are designed to meet international standards and include a wide range of facilities such as spacious playgrounds, science laboratories, large libraries filled with books, computer rooms, and even theatres for school events. In public schools, students follow a clear structure: six years of primary school, three years of intermediate school, and three years of secondary school. Each stage prepares students for the next, ensuring they gain the knowledge and skills they need.

(3) Students learn many different subjects, including Arabic, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, and Islamic Studies. Some schools also offer art, physical education, and computer science to help students develop their talents. The school day begins at 7:00 a.m. and usually ends around 2:00 p.m., giving students enough time for lessons, breaks, and activities. The school week normally runs from Sunday to Thursday, with the weekend on Friday and Saturday. In public schools, teaching is mainly in Arabic, but English is taught as a foreign language starting from the first year of primary school. In addition, some private schools teach entirely in English or other languages, offering different curricula to meet the needs of Qatar's diverse population.
