

Writing a Christmas Stanza

SCAFFOLDING TOOL 2 – WRITING FRAME AND WORD BANK (TIER 2)

This scaffold supports learners who can produce language with moderate support. Students complete the guided structure to create their own Christmas stanza, following the 8-syllable pattern (2-2-4) and 5-syllable final lines.

1. Below, complete the line using the word bank.

Follow the pattern:

- 2 syllables → **Sentence starter**
- 2 syllables → **Verb phrase**
- 4 syllables → **Christmas noun phrase**
(8 syllables pattern)

- 5 syllables → **Final lines**

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2. Repeat the phrase two more times.

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3. Bellow, complete the 5 syllable line ending using the word bank.
