AFFIRMATIVE AND NEGATIVE

Affirmative	Negative	
I / You / She / He We / They	took some photos. saw lots of bands.	I / You / She / He We / They didn't meet a friend. drink water.

Irregular verbs don't follow a regular pattern in the affirmative form of the Past Simple:

- We **went** to a music festival. We **saw** lots of bands.

But in the negative form, irregular verbs work like regular verbs, we use the auxiliary **did + not (didn't) + the infinitive of a verb:**

- They **didn't go** to the cinema.
