"OK. Let's get the same main dish. Then we can order an appetizer."

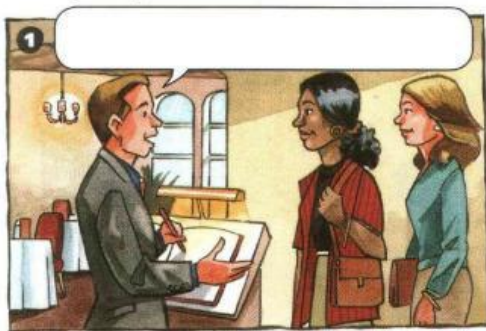
C Join another pair What do you suggest for someone who . . . ?
