

**to:** listen to, get married to, look forward to

**on:** spend money on, on purpose, on+day/date, on time

**of:** accuse of, afraid of

**for:** for+period of time (e.g. for a few days), prepared for smth (but prepared **to V1**), ask for

**at:** at the age of, at the same time, at + 'event' (at the party)

**in:** in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening, participate in

**No preposition:** enter smth, ... years older, influence sb, call sb, leave home etc.
