Where **are** you **from**? (We're **from** Manila.)
Where **is** he **from**? (He's **from** Canada.)
Are you **from** Korea? (Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.)
Is she **from** São Paulo? (Yes, she is. / No, she's not. OR No, she isn't.)

Contractions
Where is → **Where's**
Where are NOT ~~Where're~~

Be careful!
Are you from Japan?
Yes, I am. NOT Yes, ~~I am from~~.

Where **are** you **from**?

Me? I'm **from**
New York.
