The Vietnamese word for bread is *banh mi*, but it also refers to a type of Vietnamese traditional baguette. The Vietnamese baguette *banh mi* is filled with meat, vegetables, butter, and sauce. This way of making the *banh mi* looks like making a sandwich. That is why **foreigners** call it a sandwich although its shape is a baguette.

People can choose from a wide variety of **main** ingredients (grilled pork, fish patty, fried egg, etc.) and vegetables (cucumber, onion, carrot, etc.) to fill the *banh mi*. Depending on the main ingredients, there are varieties of *banh mi* such as *banh mi thit* (pork sandwich), *banh mi thit nuong* (grilled pork sandwich), *banh mi*

cha lua (pork sausage sandwich), *banh mi cha ca* (fish patty sandwich), *banh mi op-la* (fried egg sandwich), *banh mi ca moi* (sardine sandwich), etc. *Banh mi* is sometimes considered as a street food, but it can be served as a main food. Many people even choose *banh mi* for their breakfast. *Banh mi* along with *pho*, *bun*, *xoi* and many other traditional dishes, is the beauty of Vietnamese cuisine.
