

You'll get a situation and a set of words.


Your task is to organise the words and discover the phrases.

The situation: Selling a new drug to a doctor.

### GROUP 1 – Selling a new drug to a doctor

#### Phrase 1

**If the doctor strongly questioned the long-term benefits, I would present the clinical data more thoroughly.**

 Scrambled words:

**if / the doctor / strongly / questioned / clinical / data / I / would / present / long-term / benefits / more / thoroughly**

#### Phrase 2

**If the doctor reacted cautiously, I might slow down the presentation and focus on safety.**

 Scrambled words:

**if / doctor / reacted / cautiously / I / might / slow / down / presentation / and / focus / on / safety**

---

#### Model sentence 3

**If their level of trust increased slightly, they could consider prescribing the drug.**

 Scrambled words:

**if / level / of / trust / increased / slightly / they / could / consider / prescribing / drug**

#### Model sentence 4

**If the doctor remained highly skeptical, I wouldn't push for an immediate decision.**

 Scrambled words:

**if / doctor / remained / highly / skeptical / I / wouldn't / push / for / immediate / decision**

### GROUP 2 – Making a job proposal / promotion

#### Model sentence 1

**If the role aligned closely with my skills, I would accept the offer.**

 Scrambled words:

**if / role / aligned / closely / with / my / skills / I / would / accept / offer**

#### Model sentence 2

**If the company hesitated slightly, I might negotiate the terms.**

 Scrambled words:

**if / company / hesitated / slightly / I / might / negotiate / terms**

✔ **Model sentence 3**

If the expectations were extremely unclear, I would ask for clarification.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / expectations / were / extremely / unclear / I / would / ask / for / clarification

✔ **Model sentence 4**

If I felt deeply undervalued, I could walk away from the proposal.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / I / felt / deeply / undervalued / I / could / walk / away / from / proposal

📁 **GROUP 3 – Having an argument with a friend**

✔ **Model sentence 1**

If my friend reacted extremely emotionally, I would step back from the conversation.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / my / friend / reacted / extremely / emotionally / I / would / step / back / from / conversation

---

✔ **Model sentence 2**

If they slightly misunderstood my intentions, I might explain myself more calmly.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / they / slightly / misunderstood / my / intentions / I / might / explain / myself / more / calmly

---

✔ **Model sentence 3**

If the conversation escalated too quickly, I could pause it and take a break.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / conversation / escalated / too / quickly / I / could / pause / it / and / take / break

---

✔ **Model sentence 4**

If I felt genuinely respected, I would open up more.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / I / felt / genuinely / respected / I / would / open / up / more

📁 **GROUP 4 – Making an investment decision**

✔ **Model sentence 1**

If the market shifted suddenly, I might delay the investment.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / market / shifted / suddenly / I / might / delay / investment

---

✅ **Model sentence 2**

If the risk seemed extremely high, I would diversify my portfolio.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / risk / seemed / extremely / high / I / would / diversify / my / portfolio

---

✅ **Model sentence 3**

If the returns looked moderately promising, I could proceed cautiously.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / returns / looked / moderately / promising / I / could / proceed / cautiously

---

✅ **Model sentence 4**

If I didn't have enough information, I wouldn't invest immediately.

🔀 Scrambled words:

if / I / didn't / have / enough / information / I / wouldn't / invest / immediately
