II. METHOD

❖ Mẹo: Dự đoán đáp án

1. **Đọc câu hỏi kỹ** → gạch chân từ khóa (day, place, time, thing...).
2. **Đoán chủ đề cần điền** → là người, địa điểm, thời gian, đồ vật hay hành động.
3. **Đọc lại cẩn thận** → tìm chi tiết trùng với từ khóa, chú ý cách nói đồng nghĩa.
4. **Kiểm tra lại** → điền xong đọc cả câu, xem có hợp ngữ cảnh & ngữ pháp không.

Ví dụ: (Classwork exercise 1)

Bước 1: Đọc câu hỏi

Câu hỏi: "What is the text about?"

A. Mars

B. Earth

C. Moons

→ Đây là dạng câu hỏi **main idea** (ý chính của đoạn văn).

Bước 2: Đoán chủ đề

Trước khi nhìn chi tiết bài, dựa vào tiêu đề: “All About Mars”

→ Tên bài đã gợi ý rõ ràng rằng nội dung sẽ xoay quanh sao Hỏa (Mars).

Ngoài ra, ngay dòng đầu tiên ghi: “Mars is a cold desert world.”

→ Cho thấy toàn bộ đoạn đọc tập trung vào mô tả hành tinh Mars.

Bước 3: Đọc câu trả lời

Tìm các từ/cụm từ được nhắc lại nhiều lần:

- “**Mars** is a cold desert world.”
- “Mars is sometimes called the Red Planet.”
- “Scientists want to know if **Mars** may have had living things...”

Bước 4: Kiểm tra lại

Câu trả lời A hợp lý vì phù hợp với ngữ cảnh.

Ví dụ: (Classwork exercise 2)

Bước 1: Đọc câu hỏi

Câu hỏi: “I’m having a great time here! We are (0) ____ a lovely island ...”

→ Sau “are” cần một cụm giới từ chỉ vị trí phù hợp.

Bước 2: Đoán chủ đề

Chủ đề: **location (nơi chốn)** → giới từ chỉ vị trí.

Các giới từ thường gặp trong bài viết dạng holiday postcard:

- **on** (trên đảo)
- **in** (trong thành phố/quốc gia)
- **at** (địa điểm cụ thể)

Bước 3: Đọc câu trả lời

Tiếng Anh luôn dùng:

- **on an island** (đúng collocation)

Bước 4: Kiểm tra lại

Đáp án “on” là hợp lý và duy nhất đúng.

Nghĩa của câu trở nên **tự nhiên và đúng văn cảnh**:

→ We are on a lovely island in the Canary Islands, called La Palma.
