School Events Around the World

Bunkasai is a Japanese school festival. It happens every year at most schools in Japan. It is a kind of open house. Students show their work to parents and other visitors. Students also make art displays, put on shows, and sell food. *Bunkasai* is open to everyone, not just students. So, sometimes students who have graduated go back to their old schools to visit.

In Indonesia, flag raising is an important part of school life. The flag raising ceremony is called *upacara*. It happens at important school events. The most important flag raising ceremony of the year happens on Independence Day. Students stand in straight lines and salute the school principal. The principal gives speeches to encourage and educate the students. The ceremony is a great way for students to show pride in their country.

Teacher's Day is an event in many different countries. It is a really popular event in Vietnam. Students prepare special performances to say thank you to their teachers. These performances include singing, traditional dancing, and orchestras. Sometimes famous pop singers go back to their old schools to perform. Students also give flowers and other gifts to their teachers. On this day, students remember this old Vietnamese saying: "When you eat a fruit, think of the man who planted the tree."
