


The picture below shows the recycling process of wasted glass bottles.

The given diagram (1).....information about how used glass bottles are recycled.

In general, it can be seen that there are three (2).....in this process, (3).....the collection of used bottles, and (4).....newly recycled bottles used for storing drinks (5).....in supermarkets.

At the first stage of the process, glass bottles are used by customers and (6).....at a collection point (7).....being delivered to a cleaning plant. The second stage (8).....when the bottles are washed with (9)....., and subsequently sorted based on their colour (green, brown and clear) (10)....., the bottles are broken down into pieces in a glass factory and melted in a furnace (11)..... The recycled liquid glass is (12).....mixed with new liquid glass and (13).....to form new glass bottles.

(13).....the final stage of the process, the recycled bottles are (14)....., and then (15).....to supermarkets to be sold.
