Bella the Leopard lives in Safari City with her animal friends. All of them receive money every week, but they get it in different ways.


Most of the animals, about 60%, get their money from their parents. Another 20% earn money by working on Saturdays at places like the Safari Café or the Zoo Shop. About 10% do small jobs such as cleaning animal houses, washing cages, or helping visitors. The last 10% receive money as birthday or festival presents.

The animals also spend their money differently. Both boys and girls spend about two-thirds of their money on sweets and chocolate. The leopard girls and giraffe girls like to buy clothes, magazines, and beauty products more than the boys. They also spend 50% more on mobile phones than the boys.

The lion boys, on the other hand, spend more money on food and drinks, computer games, DVDs, and music.

Bella wants to become boujee, so she decides to save her money instead of spending it all on sweets and shopping. She knows that making smart choices will help her reach her goals.
