


Complete the following essay by filling in the gaps using ONE or TWO words from the word bank.

The chart below shows the results of a survey about people's coffee and tea buying and drinking habits in five Australian cities.

Summarize the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.

The bar chart illustrates the results of a survey regarding people's coffee and tea buying and drinking habits in five Australian cities, namely Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide, and Hobart.

Overall, it is clear that (1) \_\_\_\_\_ **coffee** was the most popular choice in most cities, while (2) \_\_\_\_\_ **coffee** was generally the least preferred option. Additionally, residents in Melbourne and Hobart showed (3) \_\_\_\_\_ **levels** of café visits compared to other cities.

In Sydney, approximately (4) \_\_\_\_\_ **percent** of people went to cafés for coffee or tea, which was higher than the figures for buying fresh and instant coffee. Similarly, Melbourne recorded the (5) \_\_\_\_\_ **proportion** of café coffee drinkers at just over (6) \_\_\_\_\_ **percent**.
