### SET A – Online Gambling Should Be REGULATED (Not banned)

<b>CLAIM</b> Which side of the issue do you believe in?	
<b>ARGUMENT</b> Give statements to support your claim.	
<b>EVIDENCE</b> Give facts, statistics, or concrete examples that support the argument.	
<b>COUNTER-ARGUMENT</b>

<b>Sentence 1</b>	While addiction is a risk, regulation can introduce support measures such as self-exclusion programs and mandatory break reminders, lowering the chances of harmful behavior.
<b>Sentence 2</b>	Online gambling should be regulated rather than banned because responsible oversight can reduce risks while allowing adults freedom of choice.
<b>Sentence 3</b>	Regulation makes online gambling safer by ensuring that websites follow legal standards that protect players.
<b>Sentence 4</b>	However, some argue that even with regulation, online gambling may still lead to addiction and financial problems for vulnerable individuals.
<b>Sentence 5</b>	In countries with regulated gambling, like the UK, strict policies on identity verification and spending limits have helped decrease cases of fraud and underage access.
<b>Sentence 6</b>	Therefore, regulating online gambling is a balanced approach that promotes safety, generates economic benefit, and protects both players and society.
