##### I. GRAMMAR

###### 1. Compound noun (Danh từ ghép)

Định nghĩa	Phân loại
Danh từ ghép (compound nouns) là danh từ được tạo thành bằng cách <b>ghép hai hoặc nhiều từ lại với nhau</b> để tạo ra một nghĩa cụ thể. Chúng có thể được viết dưới ba dạng chính.	<p>- <b>Danh từ ghép mở:</b> giữa 2 từ có khoảng trống. <i>E.g.</i> heart attack (<i>đau tim</i>), post office, football field, swimming pool, etc.</p> <p>- <b>Danh từ ghép nối:</b> giữa các từ có dấu gạch nối. <i>E.g.</i> father-in-law (<i>bố vợ/ chồng</i>)</p> <p>- <b>Danh từ ghép đóng:</b> giữa 2 từ không có khoảng trống. <i>E.g.</i> toothpaste, applesauce (<i>nước sốt táo</i>), submarine (<i>tàu ngầm</i>) etc.</p>

###### 2. Review: Present Continuous (Thì hiện tại tiếp diễn)

- Cách dùng:

Diễn tả hành động đang xảy ra ngay tại thời điểm nói.

*E.g.* She **is talking** on the phone **right now**.

Diễn tả hành động mang tính tạm thời.

*E.g.* I **am staying** with my cousin this week.

Diễn tả hành động gây phiền nhiễu (thường đi kèm “always”).

*E.g.* He **is always leaving** the lights on!

- Dấu hiệu nhận biết:

- now, right now, at the moment, at present
- Look! / Listen! / Watch out! / Keep silent!

- Cấu trúc:

Khẳng định	S + am/is/are V-ing.	<i>E.g.</i> Tom <b>is watching</b> TV now.
Phủ định	S + am/is/are + not + V-ing.	<i>E.g.</i> I <b>am not doing</b> my homework now.
Nghi vấn	Am/Is/Are + S + V-ing? → Yes, S + am/is/are. No, S + am/is/are + not.	<i>E.g.</i> <b>Are you listening</b> to me? → Yes, I <b>am</b> ./No, I <b>am not</b> .
	Wh + am/is/are + S + V-ing?	<i>E.g.</i> What <b>is she doing</b> now?

\*Note: S = Subject: chủ ngữ; V = Verb: động từ; is not = isn't; are not = aren't.

Articles	Missing a / an / the	Check common phrases: a party, the party, etc.
Pronouns	Confusing I / you / he / she	Make sure I = Sandra, you = Andy
Sentence length	Writing only statements, no questions	Include at least one question (e.g. What time...?)
Spelling	birthday, because, definitely	Re-read and correct common spelling mistakes
