Because

Structure:

Result + because + reason

It answers the question **Why?**

Examples:

- I like social media **because** I can talk to my friends every day.
- She trusts him **because** he always helps her.

That's why

Structure:

That's why + result

It explains **what happens because of the reason**

Examples

- He never answers my messages. **That's why** I don't text him anymore.
- She is very kind and honest. **That's why** she is an important person in my life.
