BODY PARTS OF LADYBUGS

The ladybug is a very helpful (0) *insect*. It can be red, orange, or (1)..... Some ladybugs have many (2) black on their wings but some don't. Like other insects, ladybugs have three parts to their bodies. They have a pair of (3)..... on their heads, one mouth and two eyes. The antennae are used for smell and touch.
