

SHORT VOWELS

What are short vowels?

In English, vowels do not always sound like Spanish vowels. Short vowels are **quick and short** sounds.

The same letter can have **different sounds** in different words.

In this guide, we learn five short vowel sounds.

1. /æ/ → short A

Examples: cat, bag, apple, man

Example: cat /kæt/

2. /e/ → short E

Examples: bed, pen, red, ten

Example: bed /bed/

3. /ɪ/ → short I

Examples: sit, big, fish, milk

Example: sit /sit/

4. /ɒ/ or /ɑ/ → short O

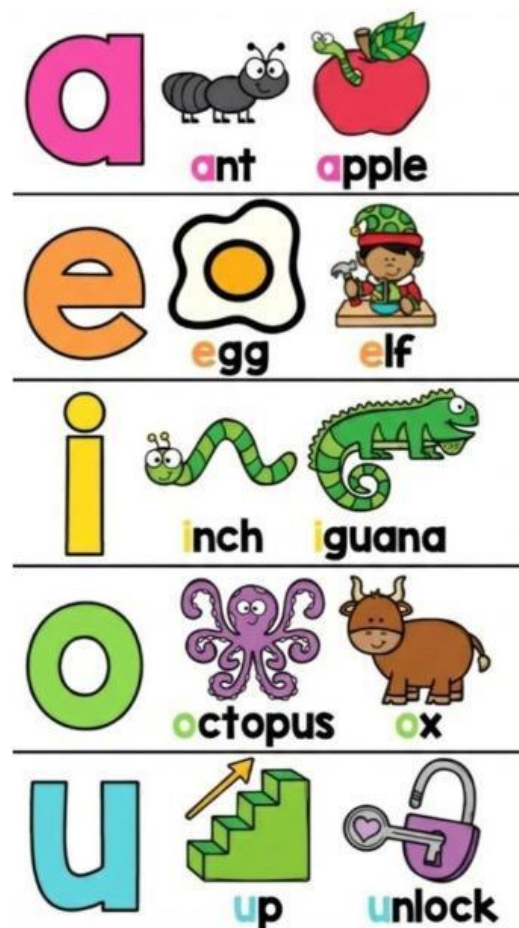
Examples: hot, dog, box, not

Example: hot /hɒt/

5. /ʌ/ → short U

Examples: cup, bus, sun, money

Example: cup /kʌp/
