

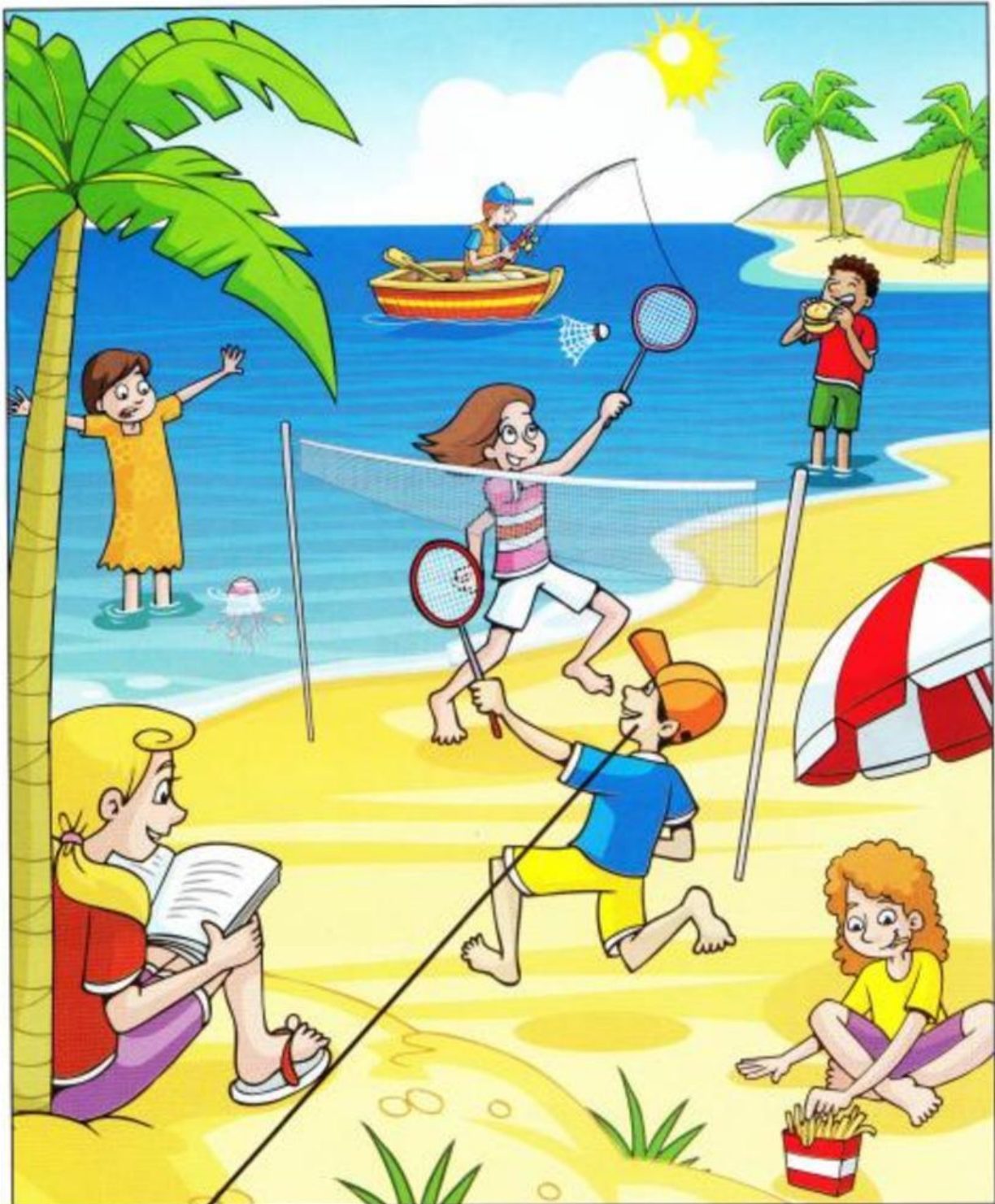
Listen and draw lines. There is one example

Woman: Who's Alice?

Boy: She's that girl, there. She's sitting under the tree.

Woman: Oh, yes. She's reading a book. Is it good?

Boy: Yes, it is. It's mine! It's about aliens.

Boy: Mark? Yes, Mark's my friend.
