

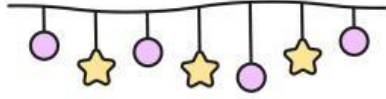
เรื่องที่ 1

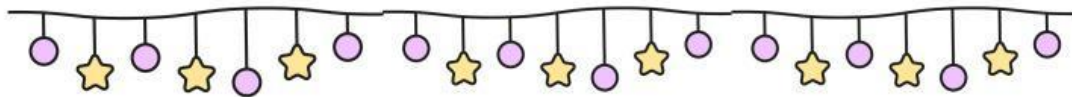
