Past Simple: regular and irregular verbs

Regular verbs	Irregular verbs
+ I wanted a bearded dragon.	I went to the kitchen.
- He didn't want Rex.	She didn't go home.
? Did she want a pet? Yes, she did ./No, she didn't .	Did she go to the kitchen? Yes, she did ./No, she didn't .
What did Mateo want ?	Why did he do that?

Past Simple verbs are irregular in the affirmative form only.
