	Regular verbs	Irregular verbs
+	I <b>wanted</b> a bearded dragon.	I <b>went</b> to the kitchen.
-	He <b>didn't want</b> Rex.	She <b>didn't go</b> home.
?	<b>Did</b> she <b>want</b> a pet? Yes, she <b>did</b> ./No, she <b>didn't</b> .	<b>Did</b> she <b>go</b> to the kitchen? Yes, she <b>did</b> ./No, she <b>didn't</b> .
	What <b>did</b> Mateo <b>want</b> ?	Why <b>did</b> he <b>do</b> that?

Past Simple verbs are irregular in the affirmative form only.
