

Increasing Decreasing Quantities by a Ratio

Increase \$70 by a ratio of 9 : 7

Change Both Values to Fractions

Increase $\frac{\$70}{1}$ by $\frac{9}{7}$

Multiply Quantities

$$\frac{70}{1} \times \frac{9}{7}$$

The increased value is \$90

Decrease \$80 by a ratio of 3 : 4

Change Both Values to Fractions

Increase $\frac{\$80}{1}$ by $\frac{3}{4}$

Multiply Quantities

$$\frac{80}{1} \times \frac{3}{4}$$

The decreased value is \$60
