## Vocabulary Words

### School Types and Concepts:

- **School holidays** - periods when school is closed and students have time off
- **Homeschool** - education received at home instead of at a school building
- **School leavers** - students who have finished their education and left school
- **Mixed school** - a school where both boys and girls study together
- **Primary school** - school for younger children, usually ages 5-11
- **School rules** - regulations that students must follow at school
- **Secondary school** - school for older students, usually ages 11-18
- **Single-sex school** - a school where only boys or only girls study
- **School uniform** - special clothing that students wear to school

### Learning Actions:

- **Enrol in** - register or sign up for a school or course
- **Get a qualification** - earn a certificate or degree after completing studies
- **Get good marks** - receive high grades or scores in tests
- **Get into college** - be accepted to attend a college or university
- **Go to lessons** - attend classes at school
- **Obey rules** - follow and respect school regulations
- **Pass exams** - succeed in tests and receive a passing grade
- **Take classes** - participate in and attend courses or lessons
