Spelling and Codes in the past

Most people have trouble spelling. In fact, about 100 years ago, Andrew Carnegie tried to make changes in the English language. He correctly predicted that English would become the most important language in the world. So, his group wanted to make English easier to read and write, created new spellings for 300 common words. The men believed that words should be spelled the way they sound. For example, **surprise** was spelled **surprize**, **ghost** became **gost**, and **through** became **thru**.

Named after Julius Caesar, the emperor of ancient Rome, this code is a simple system. The key tells you to shift the letter of the alphabet by a certain number to the left or to the right. The coded message below uses the key "Right 3", which means that if you see an E, you would count on 3 letters to the right and replace it with an H. When you get to the end of the alphabet, count round to the beginning again.
