One building stands out in the New York City skyline. It's the tallest building in the USA: One World Trade Center. It is 400 feet higher than the old World Trade Center, which it replaced after the attacks on September 11, 2010.

Baseball is one of the most popular sports in the USA and New Yorkers especially love it. Their team is called the 'New York Yankees'. Some of their players are among the most popular and best-playing stars in the country.

New York is home to many modern American cultural movements like street art, hip-hop, DJ-ing, rapping and breakdancing. Hip-hop started in the Bronx in the 1960s. Instead of fighting in the streets, many young people challenged each other in breakdance and rap competitions.

The Statue of Liberty was a present from France to celebrate 100 years of American independence. The French lent it across the Atlantic in pieces. It opened in 1886. For immigrants it became a symbol of hope for their new life.
