



He speaks Spanish.

+ Affirmative:


They live in London.

+ Affirmative:

She lives in Paris.

Third person verbs need the final s in affirmative sentences.

- Negative




• The base form of the infinitive
= ~~to~~ go, ~~to~~ need, ~~to~~ speak, ~~to~~ live

Third person verbs lose the final
"s" in negative sentences.

+ Affirmative: I speak Spanish.
- Negative: I **don't** speak Spanish.

+ Affirmative: She speaks Italian.
- Negative: She **doesn't** speak Italian.

= ~~to~~ go, ~~to~~ need, ~~to~~ speak, ~~to~~ live

Third person verbs lose the final
"s" in questions.

+ Affirmative: You speak English.
? Question: **Do** you speak English?

+ Affirmative: He speaks German.
? Question: **Does** he speak German?
