

Circumferences of Circles

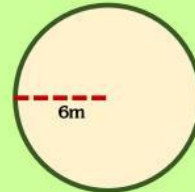
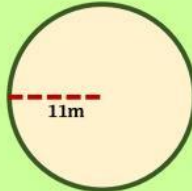
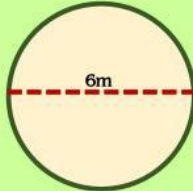
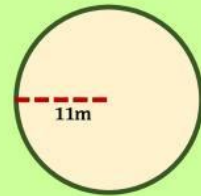
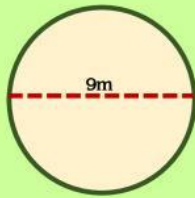
Two Formulae are Available

$$\text{Circumference} = \pi d \text{ or } 2\pi r$$

If the diameter is given, multiply it by π
Circumference = 9m times 3.14 = 28.26m

If the radius is given, multiply it by 2π
Circumference = 11m times 2 times 3.14 = 69.08m

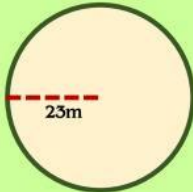
Use $\pi = 3.14$ for all calculations



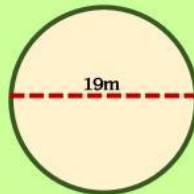
