Compare these sentences:

+ Affirmative: I **will** be ready in five minutes.

– Negative: I **will not** be ready in five minutes.

– Negative: I **won't** be ready in five minutes.

+ Affirmative: She **will** arrive on time.

– Negative: She **will not** arrive on time.

– Negative: She **won't** arrive on time.

In spoken English, the contraction **WON'T** is used more.

| I <b>will</b>    | → | I <b>will not</b>    | = | I <b>won't</b>    |
| You <b>will</b>  | → | You <b>will not</b>  | = | You <b>won't</b>  |
| He <b>will</b>   | → | He <b>will not</b>   | = | He <b>won't</b>   |
| She <b>will</b>  | → | She <b>will not</b>  | = | She <b>won't</b>  |
| It <b>will</b>   | → | It <b>will not</b>   | = | It <b>won't</b>   |
| We <b>will</b>   | → | We <b>will not</b>   | = | We <b>won't</b>   |
| They <b>will</b> | → | They <b>will not</b> | = | They <b>won't</b> |
