Compare these sentences:

+ Affirmative: I **will** be ready in five minutes.

– Negative: I **will not** be ready in five minutes.

– Negative: I **won't** be ready in five minutes.

+ Affirmative: She **will** arrive on time.

– Negative: She **will not** arrive on time.

– Negative: She **won't** arrive on time.



In spoken English, the contraction **WON'T** is used more.

I	<b>will</b>	→	I	<b>will not</b>	=	I	<b>won't</b>
You	<b>will</b>	→	You	<b>will not</b>	=	You	<b>won't</b>
He	<b>will</b>	→	He	<b>will not</b>	=	He	<b>won't</b>
She	<b>will</b>	→	She	<b>will not</b>	=	She	<b>won't</b>
It	<b>will</b>	→	It	<b>will not</b>	=	It	<b>won't</b>
We	<b>will</b>	→	We	<b>will not</b>	=	We	<b>won't</b>
They	<b>will</b>	→	They	<b>will not</b>	=	They	<b>won't</b>
