- Fame - being well-known / Famous - well-known by many people
- Kindness - quality of being kind / Kind - caring and helpful
- Strength - physical or mental power / Strong - having power and ability
- Success - achieving goals / Successful - achieving desired results
- Talent - natural ability / Talented - having natural ability
- Weakness - lack of strength / Weak - lacking strength or power
