### Notes for the teacher

- What electrical items do you use at home every day and every week?

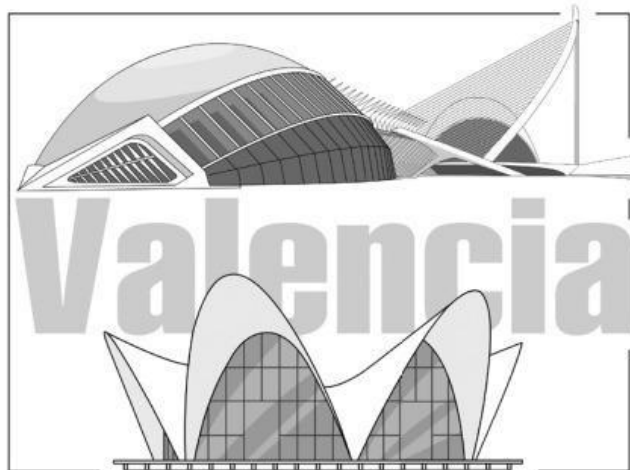
