### WHY NOT TRY ... CARIBBEAN FOOD?

Some international food is famous all over the world. You can find Chinese and Italian restaurants everywhere. Why then, aren't there more Caribbean restaurants in Europe?

Caribbean food is delicious.<sup>1</sup> There are vegetarian dishes for non-meat eaters. There is spicy food for people who like it. There are a lot of fish recipes, and fruit and vegetables give lots of dishes a beautiful flavour.
