Urban development and rural emptying are two sides of the same 21st-century coin, and are global in their extent. In the 19th and 20th centuries, as populations across the world (18) _____, urbanisation processes didn't necessarily affect rural regions negatively. In the 21st century, however, as family size has shrunk dramatically nearly everywhere, the benefits of (20) _____ have come to an end in developed countries.

Demographers would have known then that, should conditions persist, the country would eventually slip into depopulation.
