Present Perfect – Explanation

The **present perfect** tense is used to talk about actions or situations that:

1. **Started in the past and continue until now**
 - *I have lived here for 5 years.*
(I still live here.)
 2. **Happened at an unspecified time in the past**
 - *She has visited Paris.*
(We don't say when.)
 3. **Have a result in the present**
 - *He has lost his keys.*
(He doesn't have them now.)
 4. **Have happened recently** (often with *just, already, yet*)
 - *They have just finished their homework.*

◆ Structure

Affirmative:

Subject + **have/has** + past participle

- I have eaten.
- She has gone.

Negative:

Subject + **have/has not** + past participle

- I have not (haven't) eaten.
- She has not (hasn't) gone.

Question:

Have/Has + subject + past participle?

- Have you finished?
 - Has he arrived?
