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## LES NOTES : PRONOMS, ACCENTS ET SALUTATIONS

### 1. Les Pronoms Sujets (Subject Pronouns)

These words replace names to show who is performing the action.

French	English	Context
<b>Je</b>	I	Talking about yourself
<b>Tu</b>	You	Informal / Singular (Friends/Family)
<b>Il / Elle</b>	He / She	Talking about one boy or one girl
<b>Nous</b>	We	A group including "Me"
<b>Vous</b>	You	Formal / Plural (Teachers or a group)
<b>Ils</b>	They (m)	A group of boys or a mixed group
<b>Elles</b>	They (f)	A group of girls only

### 2. Les Accents Français

Accents are essential! They change how we pronounce words.

- **L'accent aigu (') :** Found only on é (Ex: *Enchanté*). Sounds like "ay".
- **L'accent grave (') :** Found on à, è, ù (Ex: *Très, à demain*).
- **L'accent circonflexe (^) :** Found on â, ê, î, ô, û (Ex: *Fête, hôtel*).
- **La cédille (ç) :** Found only on c. Makes "c" sound like "s" (Ex: *Ca va ?*).
- **Le tréma (") :** Separates two vowels so both are heard (Ex: *Noël*).

### 3. Les Salutations (Hi & Bye)

- **Hi:** *Bonjour* (Formal), *Salut* (Informal), *Coucou* (Friendly).
- **Bye:** *Au revoir* (Formal), *À demain* (Tomorrow), *À bientôt* (Soon), *Bonne nuit* (Night).
