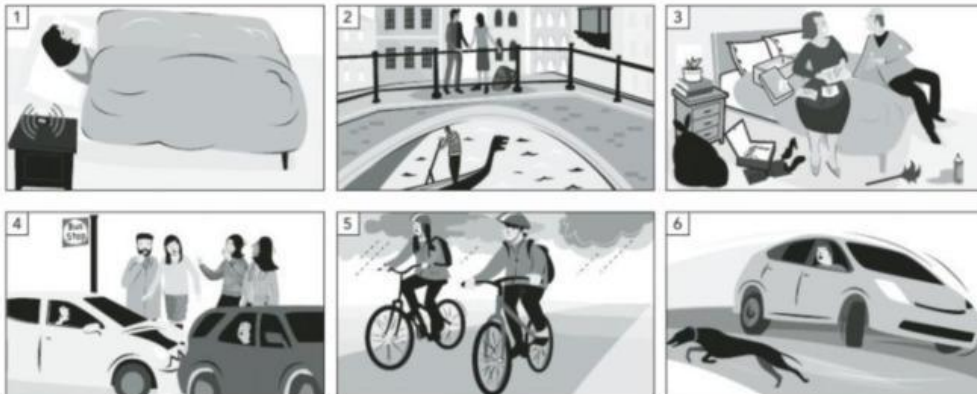

Monica and Diana looked up and saw cars and trees flying above the school. 'It was very scary. The whole school was shaking,' said Monica.

When the storm passed, Monica and her mum returned home, but it was in ruins. They couldn't find Pete. But they could hear him shouting for help. Then they saw his hand and his face – in a cupboard under the stairs. He couldn't breathe, so they had to get him out quickly. Moments after they pulled him out, the whole house collapsed. The family survived a terrifying experience with only small injuries. But other people in the town were not as lucky as the Palmores. Twenty-four people died in the tornado.

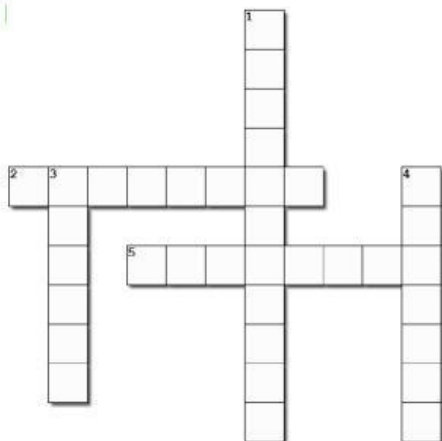
