#### A brief history of the Beatles

Have you ever heard of the four boys who shook the world, the Fab Four? If you haven't, The Beatles were an English rock band, formed in Liverpool in 1960. With members John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison, and Ringo Starr, they were the most brilliant band of the 1960s.

The Beatles built their reputation performing clubs in Liverpool and Hamburg over a three-year period from 1960. Ringo played drums, George and John played guitar, and Paul played bass guitar.

They were very popular in the UK after their first hit, *Love Me Do*, in 1962, and "Beatlemania" was used to describe their crazy fans. Beatlemania grew in Britain, and by early 1964 they became huge international stars, leading the "British Invasion" of the United States.

From 1965, the Beatles created their best music, including the albums, *Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band* (1967) and *Abbey Road* (1969).

After their break-up in 1970, they all had successful musical careers. Sadly, John and George have died, so it's now just Ringo and Paul.
