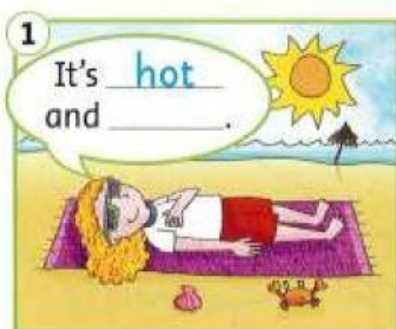




Exercise 1: What is the weather like? Complete the sentences
