7. motor-cars, and his first experimental model appeared in 1903. Shortly after that, either
8. Charles Rolls and Henry Royce met, forming on the Rolls-Royce manufacturing firm in
9. 1904. Royce was designed the motor-cars and Rolls sold them. Rolls, who had earned
10. himself a reputation as a keen racing motorist, also had a lot passion for flying. In 1910,
11. at the age of only 33, did he sadly met his death in a plane crash. Royce, however, carried
12. on work on their shared dream, and went to be develop his first aero-engine in 1915. On
13. Royce's death in 1933, which the famous Rolls-Royce monogram was changed from red to
14. black such as a sign of respect for the great man.
