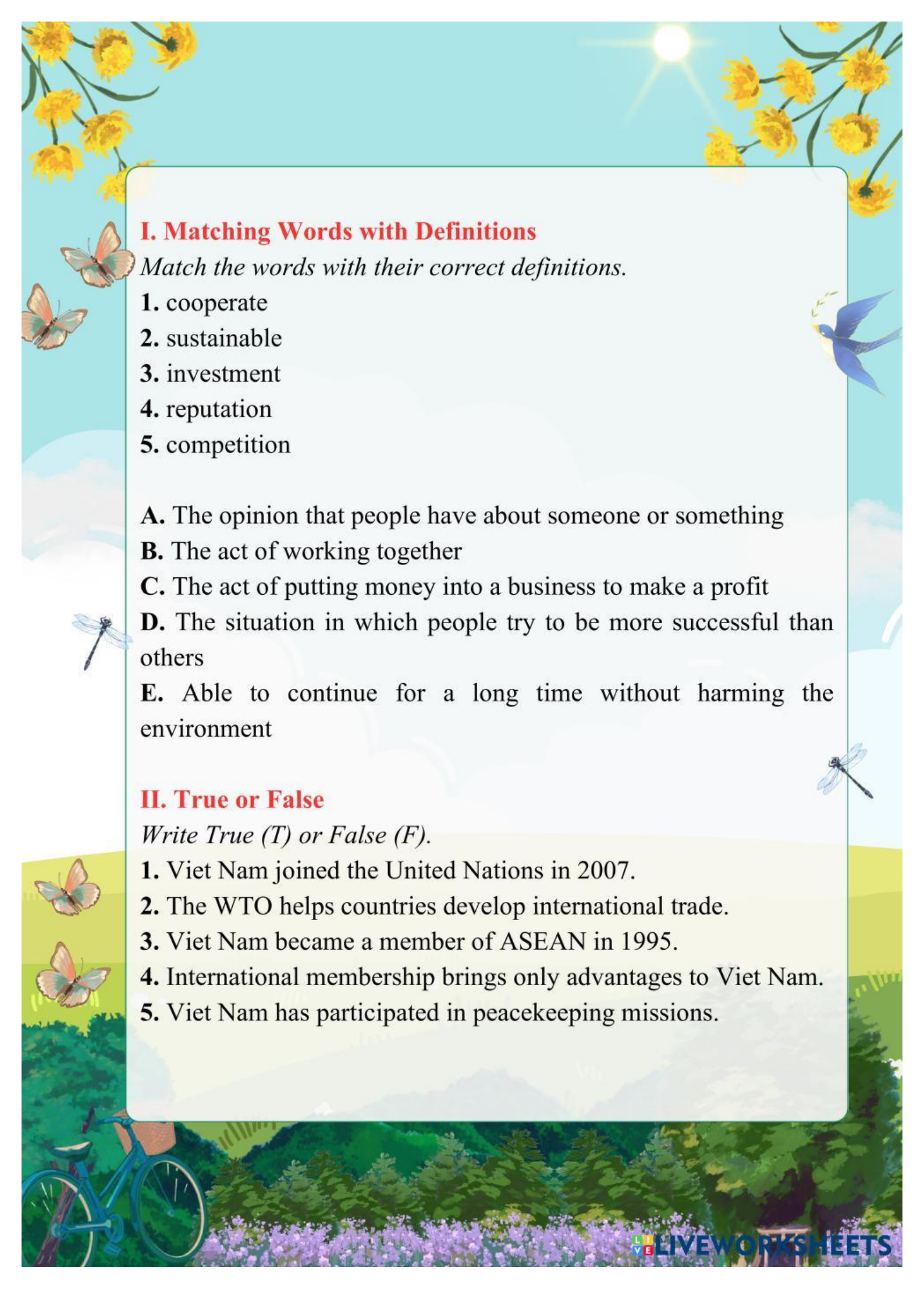
VIET NAM AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS
